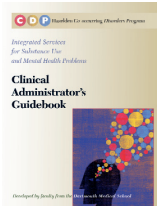


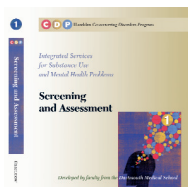

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

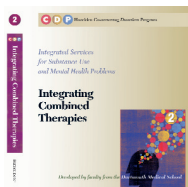

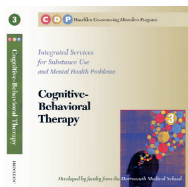

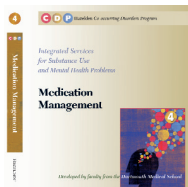
- ← **Curriculum 1 *Screening and Assessment***
Includes a three-ring binder, a clinician's guide, and a CD-ROM.



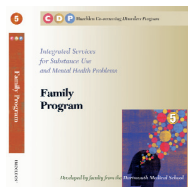
- ← **Curriculum 2 *Integrating Combined Therapies***
Includes a three-ring binder, a clinician's guide, and a CD-ROM.



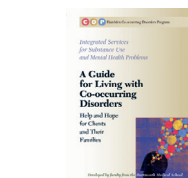
