



# Your guide to program rates for Hazelden's Adolescent and Young Adult Services in Plymouth, Minnesota

## Evaluations

Both residential and outpatient evaluations are available. The evaluation period is typically 7-10 days during which the participant is integrated with peers in the residential primary program. Recommendations for care are made at the end of the evaluation period.

<b>Residential evaluation estimated rate</b>	\$11,130
<b>Outpatient evaluation estimated rate</b>	\$ 7,330

## Residential Program

Rate covers room and board, integrated clinical care including individual counseling and group therapy, educational and therapeutic programming, and wellness and recreational activities. All patients are admitted into our medical services unit for evaluation and/or detoxification for at least one day. Mental health services are integrated into the treatment process and are charged on a fee-for-service basis.

## Residential Extended Care

Rate covers room and board, integrated clinical care to address long-term recovery and transitional living issues, and an educational/vocational assessment. Mental health services are available on a fee-for-service basis.

<b>Daily rate</b>	\$420

## Outpatient Day Treatment

Rate covers integrated clinical care including individual counseling and group therapy, educational and therapeutic programming, and wellness and recreational activities. Day treatment services are available on a limited basis for local patients who have a supportive home environment and reliable transportation. Mental health services are available on a fee-for-service basis.

## Hazelden Connection

Rate covers 18 months of recovery coaching and support for participant 18 years of age and older and up to two family members or concerned persons. The program also includes accountability verification reports and random drug testing.

## Parent Program

### Two primary caregivers may attend Parent Program at no cost.

Additional caregivers wishing to attend are required to pay the rate below. The rate includes educational programs and materials, process groups, a family conference, and lunches Monday through Wednesday. An optional half-hour meeting with your child's mental health professional is available for a service fee.

## Sibling Program

A four-day program for all siblings ages 12 and older concerned about their brother or sister's chemical use. They do not have to have a brother or sister at Hazelden's Plymouth campus. This free program is an educational and supportive service to help siblings learn about the disease of addiction and how it affects them, their brother or sister, and their family.

## Teen Intervene

Teen Intervene is designed to provide education, support, and guidance for teens who have experienced mild to moderate substance abuse. The program consists of three 90-minute sessions. The first two sessions are one-on-ones with the teen and the counselor. The parent(s) or guardian(s) join the third session.

## Mental Health Services

Services for patients and their family members are integrated into the treatment process and are charged on a fee-for-service basis. Services, such as mental health assessments, individual or group therapy, vary in cost by type and length of service. These services are also available to alumni and community members not enrolled in treatment.
