



Your guide to program rates at Hazelden's Tribeca Twelve residence in Tribeca, New York

Tribeca Twelve Collegiate Housing Rates

Pricing is \$5,000 to \$5,500 per month depending on semi-private rooms and length of commitment.

**Semi-private,
2 residents per room** \$5,500 per month

**Shared rooms,
4 residents per room** \$5,250 per month

With a 12 month commitment \$5,000 per month

Minimum stay requirements

A minimum stay of 90 days is required unless earlier terminated at Hazelden's request. A 90 day stay is considered the minimum to support young adults in early recovery following treatment completion and the stress of attending school and learning new life skills to remain sober.

Covered and non-covered services

The program fees includes fully furnished 2,200 square-foot apartments, in-unit laundry, periodic housekeeping, utilities, flat screen TV, kitchen supplies, wireless internet and cable service and professional recovery services including individualized recovery coaching, recovery care plans, program activities, academic liaison support, routine drug testing, family and friends portal, coordination of treatment and recovery housing supports, and other miscellaneous services. Residents also have access to community spaces for gatherings, meetings and social activities.

Residents are responsible to pay for food, medications, non-routine drug testing, professional treatment services, and special services (e.g., meetings with off-site treatment providers).

Payment terms

A non-refundable application fee of \$300 plus the first month program fee is due on execution of the Admission License Agreement. The program fees will be refunded if the admission is terminated by Hazelden for any reason prior to move-in. If the resident terminates the Agreement prior to move-in, the first month fee is non-refundable. If the resident terminates the Agreement after move-in, the first 90 day program fees are non-refundable. The program fees may be refunded for cause, including Hazelden's recommendation for referral to a higher level of care, acute medical emergency, family emergency, expulsion from school and military service.

Financial aid available

Costs of the housing may be funded through student loans in accordance with student loan requirements. Program scholarships may be available through donor funding for financially qualifying students.

Health insurance coverage

Professional treatment and continuing care services may be reimbursed by commercial insurance. Hazelden is insurance friendly. The recovery supports in the residence program may not be eligible for insurance payment.
