



CALL FOR ENTRIES: HAZELDEN'S TRIBECA TWELVE RESIDENCE

Hazelden New York is sponsoring a design competition for its new collegiate recovery residence located in Tribeca New York. Hazelden is a non-profit dedicated to helping more people find recovery from addiction to drugs and alcohol. The residence is a newly renovated six-story building set to open July, 2011. Five floors are dedicated to 2,200 sq. ft. single floor residences for young men and women (18-29) needing a fun, safe and sober place to live and attend college. Each residence offers a large living room with a fireplace, full kitchen, dining room, separate study, in-suite laundry, two full bathrooms and bedrooms with individualized storage. The residence offers a fun and exciting peer supported living experience with personal recovery coaches, a variety of activities, separate meeting space, and the support needed to live life to the fullest.

This competition will focus on the design of the roof top deck as an outdoor environment and will address the following criteria:

- Provide a creative, attractive, contemporary and multi-functional roof top design for young adults aged 18-29 living in the residence
- Flexible design to incorporate activities that support the objectives of the program (outdoor activity, cooking, relaxing, socializing in a safe environment)
- Reflect evidence based principles of healthcare design with references to nature, separate areas for flexible seating, entertaining, outdoor cooking and to visit with friends and family
- Use of durable equipment, furniture and finishes to keep maintenance to a minimum
- Address the safety of residents including types of materials, lighting, access, and security
- Incorporate value analysis to achieve a total project budget of up to \$20,000 (excluding electrical and water for roof top activities)

The competition is open to all currently enrolled students in an undergraduate, graduate or post-graduate program of study in interior design, landscape architecture or architecture. The first, second and third place winners will be invited to the ribbon cutting ceremony along with a display of the winning designs. A cash prize will be awarded to the winning first place entry (\$2,500), second place (\$1,500) and third place (\$500).

How to Enter: Individuals or teams *must register* via email no later than May 15, 2011 to be eligible for the competition. Registration email must include the name(s) of the entrant(s), address, phone number, school and degree concentration along with a copy of the student's valid photo ID. Registrations must be e-mailed to reg.tribeca12@gmail.com no later than 11:59pm EST on May 15, 2011 to be eligible.

All qualifying entrants, as determined by Hazelden, will be provided electronic drawings for the roof top deck along with photos and other materials. All questions should be directed by email to the competition email address, tribeca12@gmail.com. We will endeavor to answer all questions and provide an online list of questions and answers for all registrants.

Final Design Submission: Final design submissions shall be formatted as (1) 24"x36" presentation board, including scaled design drawings, renderings and any other presentation techniques required to communicate the environment. The final design shall be submitted as a pdf to tribeca12@gmail.com. All material and designs submitted will be considered a work for hire with all rights assigned to Hazelden New York. The deadline for submission of final design is June 15, 2011. Ten finalists will be announced by July 1st, 2011 and they will have the opportunity to present to Hazelden and the design committee on July 15th, 2011, at which time the top three winners will be announced. Note: Hazelden is under no obligation to install any of the winning designs.
